Marine Terminal

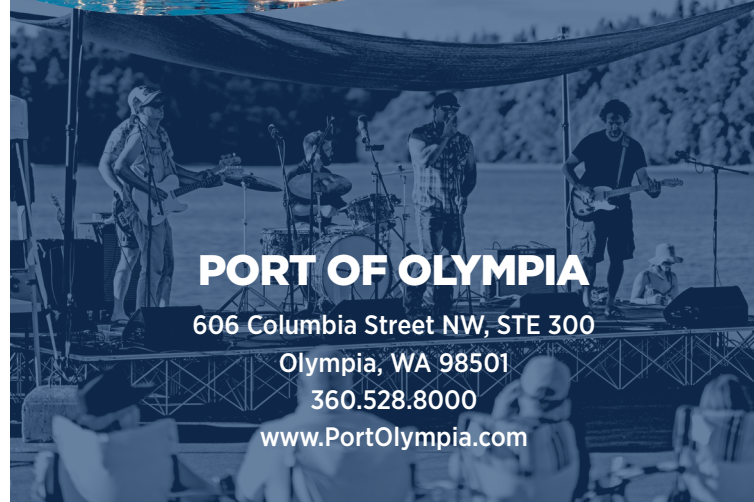

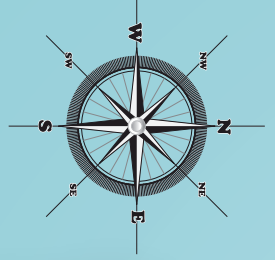
